If you think you may be interested in pursuing a professional certification, and you've been employed at Shadowfax for at least 6 months, here are some quick facts about the E-Badge Academy program-

Did you know?

- You can earn badges toward certification at your own pace
- Each badge only takes an average of 15 minutes to prepare
- Most Relias annual trainings count towards certification
- Your experience as a DSP counts towards certification
- After earning a certification within a year of enrollment, receive an hourly pay increase!

You can find the application form titled '2024 Credentialing Application' in Bamboo under Staff Info. They can be submitted at any time by scanning the completed form to sftraining@shadowfax.org.

In order to be considered for the next group starting in October 2024, applications must be received by September 1, 2024.



### **Med Task Force**

#### PRN Medications-

Many PRN medications are ordered to be given when obvious symptoms present themselves. Sometimes, though, PRN medications are related to situations rather than presenting symptoms. For example, a medication might be ordered to be given before a person goes to a dentist or doctor's appointment, to relieve anxiety. Before an appointment, it's best practice to read over individual plans and protocols, face sheets, and review all PRN medication orders. Other PRN medications are often related to a person's bowel protocol. These orders are very specific to each person, and orders and instructions for any related PRN medications should be reviewed often.

Reminder — after checking all available resources and plans, Residential staff are required to call a nurse for approval to administer any PRN medication.

### Safety Corner

#### WHEELCHAIRS

- Make sure the wheelchair is clean and wheels are properly inflated
- Ensure brakes lock properly and securely
- When transferring to or from a wheelchair ALWAYS make sure the brakes are locked
- Remove any parts of the chair that will allow for a safer transfer (footrests and armrests)
- Plan your lift/transfer
- Assess occupant's ability to assist in the transfer and gather any assistive equipment before beginning
- Ask for help BEFORE you begin if you are unsure you can do the lift/transfer by yourself



What to do when you are injured on the job

1. Notify your supervisor. 2. Go to Bamboo, select files, select Staff Info, then click on Workers' Compensation Program Designated Health Care Providers. Ensure you receive medical treatment from one of the providers listed. 3. Contact Human Resources to report the injury. HR will send you the workers' comp packet. 4. Fill out the workers' comp packet within 24 hours. 5. Keep HR and your supervisors informed.

Effective 7/29/24, if the person you refer is hired and successfully completes 6 months of employment, you will receive a lump sum payment of \$500 (minus applicable taxes).
